2. Asking around in groups and forums to determine needs and what people are willing to pay for.



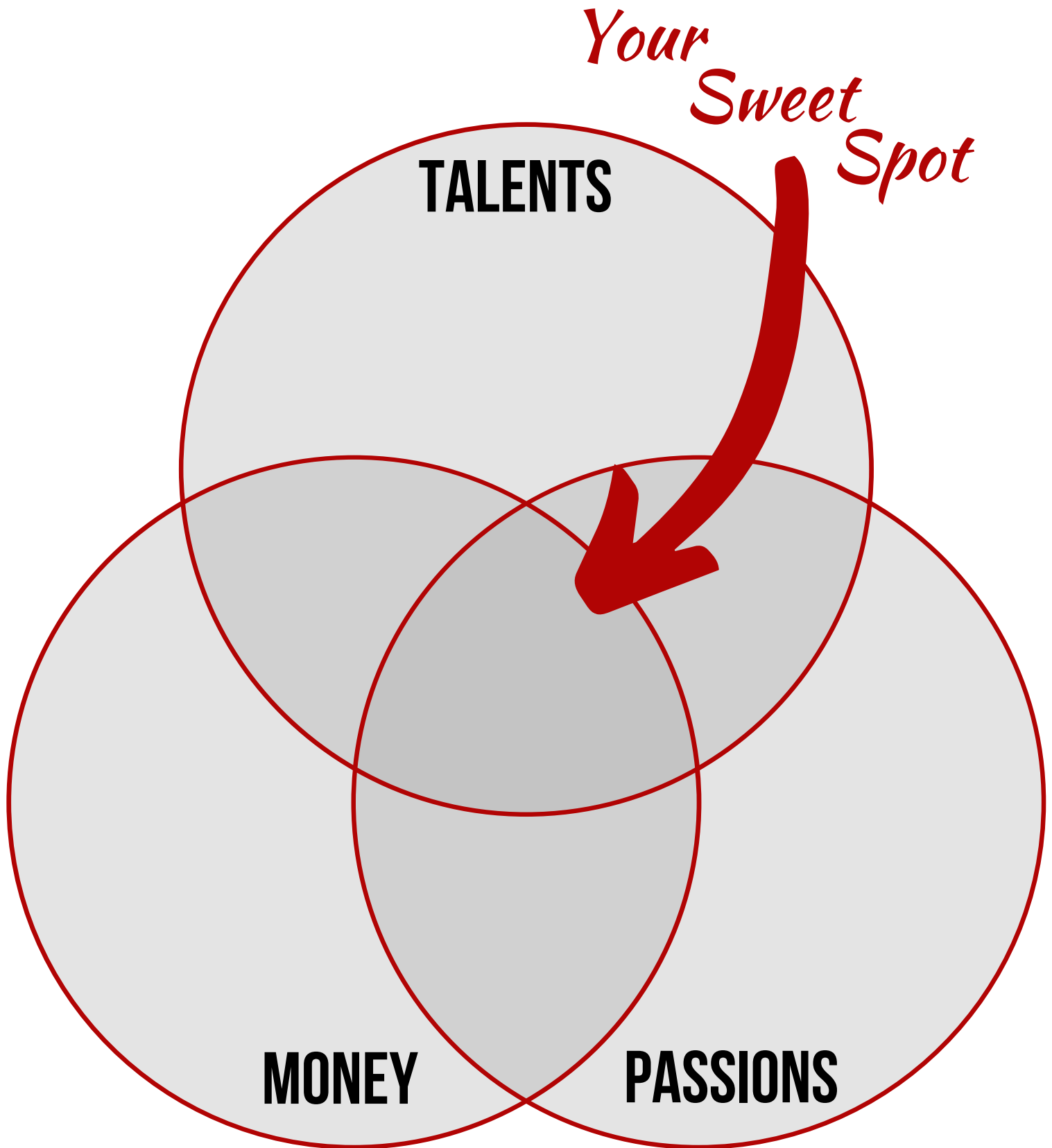
